SYNOPSIS:

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TIPS FOR SELF TAPES

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!

1. Frame yourself (the talent) from head to toe. Start off with a brief introduction into camera: state your NAME, age (for talent under 18 years old), HEIGHT, and LOCATION.
2. Now, zoom in so that you're framed from the top of the head to the mid chest area ONLY and keep that frame for the entire scene. There should be little to no space over the top of your head. Be sure that the lighting is bright. Make sure that the sound quality is clear. It is very important that we can clearly see and hear you.
3. Now, do the scene(s)! (scene(s) are attached at the bottom of this audition package) Please make sure to read the cover page carefully.
4. Feel free to tape the scene(s) as many times as you'd like, but only send us **one** take, the BEST take. ALL INSTRUCTIONS ARE ON THE LAST PAGE
5. Remember to look natural, be energetic, have fun, and just be yourself!
6. Send everything in **ONE** email to hollyhobbiecasting@gmail.com. Audition videos should be sent via a link such as YouTube. **Please make sure to set the privacy settings so that the video is UNLISTED. Auditions must not be made public. Auditions must also NOT BE LISTED AS PRIVATE. If you send us a private link we will be e-mailing you to change it to unlisted.**

INT. LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

ROBBIE watches TV with HOLLY and HEATHER.



HOLLY

Oh, here come the lottery numbers.
Got your ticket ready?

ROBBIE

What's the point? I lost my
girlfriend, I broke my leg, my
football career is over. I've never
felt less lucky in my life.

HEATHER

Robbie, what is it you always tell
me?

ROBBIE

Whoever smelt it dealt it?

HEATHER

No, the other thing... "anything is
possible."

ROBBIE

I was wrong. Nothing is possible.
Give up now.

HOLLY

Jeez, you really need to lighten up.
Shh! Here come the numbers.

Robbie pulls the crumpled ticket out of his pocket and checks
it against the numbers on the TV.

ROBBIE

Fourteen... Twenty six... Twenty
nine! Thirty seven?! You're kidding
me!!

HOLLY

What is it? Did you win?!

ROBBIE

Yeah! I did! I won...
(off the screen)
TWO MILLION DOLLARS?!?!

HEATHER

See?! Anything is possible!

ROBBIE

I take it all back - you were right!
You know what I'm going to do?

(to Holly)

I'm going to buy you a horse. No —
two horses!

(to Heather)

And I'm going to buy you a dirt bike.
And I'll buy mom and dad... whatever
it is that parents want. I'm so
sorry I've been such a jerk to you
guys. Things have been really hard
recently, but this is going to change
everything.

Holly and Heather exchange looks, like they know something
Robbie doesn't. Robbie clocks the weirdness.

ROBBIE (CONT'D)

Why'd you look at each other like
that?

HOLLY

Like how?

ROBBIE

Like you're up to something. I know
those looks.

(dawning on him)

You didn't...

Robbie picks up the TV remote and hits pause. He sees the
date. The wind is knocked out of his sails.

ROBBIE (CONT'D)

You got me a ticket with last week's
winning numbers? What the heck is
wrong with you two? Is the fact
that I'm going to be stuck in this
crappy town for the rest of my life
funny to you?!

Robbie throws the remote across the room in frustration.
Heather is stunned — she didn't mean for things to go this
far. Robbie sees the fear in her eyes and backpedals.

ROBBIE (CONT'D)

(half-hearted)

You really got me. I crown you this
month's prank champions.

Robbie walks off, humiliated.
